### Life Lesson #2: Those Who Honor God Will Be Honored By Him

1 Samuel 2:30 says "Therefore, the Lord the God of Israel, says: I promised that your branch of the tribe of Levi would always be my priests. But I will honor those who honor me, and I will despise those who think lightly of me."

God loves us unconditionally and gave us grace and mercy through Jesus.

Yet as we are to **honor** God, which means to **give him special recognition**,
we need to understand that God honors those who honor Him in a conditional manner.

**1.** What is an example in your life where you experience unconditional love, yet still have conditional honor?

# **Describing God**

If we want to honor God we need to describe God and understand who He is.

- **2.** Read 1 Kings 3:6-7 and 2 Chronicles 1:8. Solomon wished to honor God by describing to God who He is and telling God he recognizes it. When in your life have you felt recognized, understood and honored in a similar manner from a friend or family member? How did it make you feel?
- **3.** Psalm 145:12-18 is an example of King David using his prayer time as a way to give God special recognition for all that He is. After reading this passage, what qualities of God come to your mind that you want to focus on, both as you pray and as you go about your life?

**4.** 2 Chronicles 1:9-10 and 1 Kings 3:8-9 show Solomon literally asking God to help him be able to lead God's people the way God wants him to.
