Content

When we give our lives to Jesus, we receive the Holy Spirit in that moment. The Holy Spirit is essential to your life. The Spirit will grow you closer to God and change your daily life. So what does it mean when we say you will be continually "filled with the Spirit" as mentioned in Ephesians 5:18b?

Be Filled With The Spirit?

- **1.** Have you ever felt a moment in your life when you are scared, worried, or feeling unsure and yet feel an overwhelming sense of peace? Share that memory and what stands out to you about it?
- **2.** When we need a filling of the Spirit, God will do it. It can be supernatural and occur when we least expect it. Or it can be when we are surrounded by other believers, or are in the Word, or serving our God. What Scripture do you turn to when you need to be filled by the Spirit?
