Connection

What would you ask Jesus if you were sitting down for a cup of coffee with Him?

Content

"In your BOLD FAITH, BOLD HOPE and BOLD LOVE, trust Him for BIG things."

What does this statement say to you?

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James 2:19 tells us that even the demons believe the truth about God. Read Luke 8:22-24. Write here the question Jesus asked: How would you personally answer that question during this season in your life?
2. Read Mark 5:25-34. The woman had such faith that she believed she only needed to touch Jesus' robe to be healed. What would it look like for you to live your life like this woman, with bold faith?
3. Matthew 7:9-11 reminds us of how a good parent responds to their child. If you are a parent, how do you determine the way you'll respond to your children's requests? If you're not a parent, how do you think your own parents made these decisions?

With this image of God as a good parent in mind, go back and read Matthew 7:7-8. What do you need to "keep on asking" God for right now?

Bold Hope

- **4.** "When we have a bold faith, we can have a bold hope." (Romans 4:18) When have you or someone you have met expressed bold hope, even when everything in their situation seemed hopeless?
- **5.** In Luke 23:32-43 Jesus had just faced massive persecution the day before as he is beaten down, is wearing a thorn of crowns, and is crucified on a cross. Yet, a criminal expresses his hope in Jesus. This criminal didn't know Jesus would rise again in three days, any yet he chose to have a bold hope, when everyone else around him did not.

How can you relate to either of the criminals in this story?

Bold Love

6. John 15:12-13. When you give up yourself to someone else, that is a huge demonstration of love. A bold love is a selfless love. When have you received bold love from someone you didn't expect?

Trust God for BIG things. Let hope and expectation dominate your attitude. Love deeply.

Commitment

7. Do you want to grow in having a bold faith, bold hope, or bold love? How can the group be there for you and help you in this goal?

Begin with prayer. Listen with care. Eat / Engage with another. Serve. Share your story.
