Content

Read how Paul partners together with God in the sharing of the Good News in the early church found in Acts 16.

1. Often times, we can be sidetracked in our best intentions to share God with others due to conflict and opposing opinions. What happened in Acts 16:16-24 that created a detour as Paul and Silas were going to a place of prayer to preach the Good News?
2. In Acts 16:25-28, how did Paul and Silas' actions in prison show the other prisoners and the jail keeper that God was sovereign and powerful?
3. Why do you think Paul and Silas didn't escape from the jail after God sent the earthquake? What does that say about their unwavering desire to share the Gospel wherever they were?
4. Read Acts 16:29-34 and describe the reaction of the jail keeper and how his spiritual security was met beyond his imagination even though he asked to be saved physically.
